A Caring Pregnancy Center helps meet the needs of Pueblo’s unwed mothers with free diapers, baby food, clothing, and other services.

Pueblo, CO—March 31—According to a recent state health department study, nearly half the births in Pueblo County are to single mothers. “A Caring Pregnancy Center is concerned for the large number of new single moms in our community, but this is what we’re here for,” said Barbara Musso, Executive Director of the center. “Our first focus is prevention. We advocate for abstinence until marriage, however when a woman chooses otherwise and finds herself pregnant, we’re here to walk that journey with her.”

Located at 500 Colorado in Pueblo, A Caring Pregnancy Center offers multiple services including limited medical services such as pregnancy testing, maternity and baby clothing, donated baby furniture, diapers, baby food, and parenting classes. “We offer an ultrasound for every positive pregnancy test,” Musso said. “All our services are free of charge. We have a volunteer medical director who is a doctor and a nurse manager on staff. For prenatal care, we refer patients to local doctors.”

The center also offers prenatal and abbreviated childbirth classes. The center awards class attendance with WalMart gift cards and “Baby Bucks” used to purchase supplies.

Musso said, “We believe every child has value as well as being a potential benefit to our society.”
