- What did you do in response?

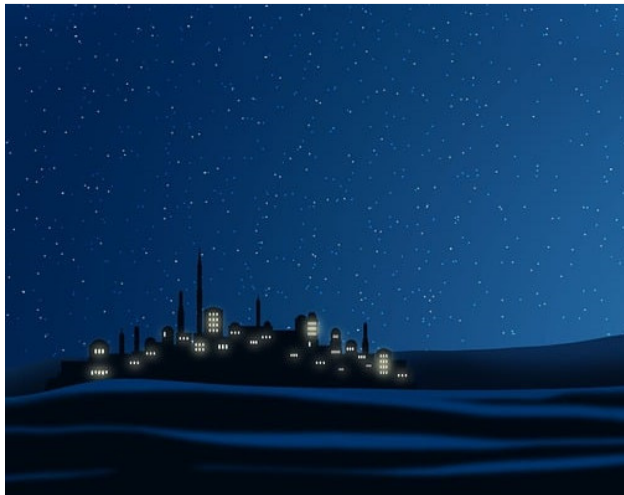


DREAM 3

- Are you waiting for further instructions from God?

READ:

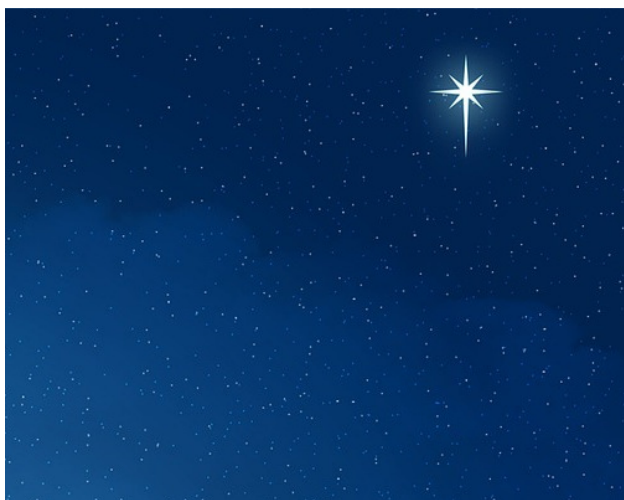
Matthew 2:19-21

- Who visited the magi in a dream (v. 13)?

- How might you learn the way God speaks to you as you experience it more often?

- How do you retain and remember what God has communicated to you and how he has done so? For example, do you write it down?

READ:

Matthew 2:22-23

- When evil people hold powerful positions, what can God's people do?

- Joseph paid attention to political leaders, what kind of people they were, and kept his family safe. How might you do this today?

- How are you trusting God to guide you today?

- What do you need to ask God about today?
